VUI HOUSE PROJECT

VUI House is a young NGO founded in 2017 to support **people living with disabilities in Vietnam**. In this country, 50% of disabled people are considered as 'living in poverty' and sell small crafts (artwork, stuffed animals, etc.) for a living. VUI House aims to **improve their living standards** by teaching them **how to market their products** and offering them access to new distribution channels. For instance, it created an online selling platform enabling their community to widen their client base and increase their revenue. The Amaris Foundation **members chose** VUI House as one of our 2018 partners, donating €30,000 towards supporting one of their projects for one and a half years.

Our objective was to **scale up the charity**, support their video awareness campaign and increase their reach amongst disabled people.
